

OIMB Scholarship Application

Oregon Institute of Marine Biology offers 6-8 scholarships and fellowships each term, ranging from \$500-\$1000 each. Use this form to apply for any of the scholarships listed below and use additional paper as needed to answer any of the questions.

- The **Alumni Association Scholarship** is awarded on the basis of merit to University of Oregon undergraduate students attending spring, summer or fall term at OIMB. Funds for these scholarships come from donations from OIMB alumni.
- The **Laura Bickerstaff Scholarship*** is awarded to junior and senior undergraduates attending spring, summer or fall term at OIMB. These awards are based on strength of personal character, an academic interest in marine and coastal habitat of Oregon, and financial need. Funds for these scholarships come from a gift to the University from the estate of a local Coos Bay resident, Laura Bickerstaff.
- The **Neil Richmond Memorial Scholarship*** is awarded on the basis of merit and need to students attending the OIMB fall or spring session. The scholarship is funded by a grant from Oregon Sea Grant and honors the memory of Neil Richmond. Neil was a marine scientist and friend who worked for the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife. This scholarship honors his spirit, curiosity and love of learning.
- The **Robert C. Terwilliger Scholarship*** is awarded on the basis of merit and need to students attending the OIMB spring or summer session to study invertebrate zoology. Students, colleagues and friends have established this fund in memory of Dr. Robert C. Terwilliger (1940-1989), professor of Biology (1970-1989) and director of OIMB. Dr. Terwilliger studied the structure and function of invertebrate blood proteins and his enthusiasm for life inspired generations of students to a deeper understanding of biology.

3. Please explain your financial need for need based scholarships – indicated by the * (see below).

5. For the R.C. Terwilliger Scholarship only – why do you want to take the Invertebrate Zoology class?
